

Xaverian 44, Attleboro 6

WESTWOOD — The Bombardiers could not contain Ikechukwa Irabor, who rushed for 152 yards on 12 carries as Xaverian High amassed 349 of its 440 net offensive yards on the ground in winning the MIAA Division 1 South playoff game.

Xaverian High scored 23 first half points, took a 30-0 lead by halftime with running back Mike Masse (92 yards on six carries) having TD runs of seven and 58 yards (with 44 seconds left) in the opening quarter. Moreover, Xaverian converted six of seven third down situations.

The Bombardiers scored their lone TD a minute into the third quarter, a three-play drive culminated by Cam Furtado completing a two-yard scoring strike to James Weir. In that march, Furtado completed a 27-yard pass to Elvin Sam and a 43-yard pass to Joe Llanos.

Furtado completed five of 12 passes for 101 yards in the game, while adding 59 yards rushing on five carries. Llanos had 53 rushing yards on nine carries and two catches for 56 yards, while Sam had two catches for 43 yards.
